



FIELD TRIP: EMS and Pre-Hospital System
Erawan Center Bangkok EMS

Background

Erawan Center Bangkok EMS is the organization under the supervision of the Medical Service Department of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA). Erawan Center Bangkok EMS has the responsibilities in relation to the management of the emergency medical services (EMS) in Bangkok areas. Mainly, the center serves as the Emergency Call and Dispatch Center of Bangkok, providing consultation and instructions for the emergency medical operations. Nowadays, the Erawan Center Bangkok EMS also acts as the coordination center connecting EMS networks in the operation to support the emergency medical operations in normal time, disaster situations and other emergencies such as accidents or the act of terrorism. Erawan Center Bangkok EMS continuously attempts to improve and develop the quality of emergency medical system of Bangkok that it tries to improve the standard of the services through EMS accreditation, together with the studies and researches on emergency medical services and system, and campaigns to promote public awareness towards emergencies.



During the field trip to Erawan Center Bangkok EMS, the participants will have the opportunity to explore the emergency medical system managed by the Erawan Center Bangkok EMS and understand the roles and responsibilities of the emergency medical technicians operated in Bangkok; including the Basic Life Support Team (BLS) and the Advance Life Support Team (ALS). In addition, the participants will have the opportunity to visit the Emergency Room of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration General Hospital and the Rescue Radio Station of the Poh Teck Tung Foundation.

Emergency Room of Klang Hospital offers 24-hour emergency medical treatments to the patients who have been assaulted, injured from road traffic accidents or suffered from other kinds of emergencies.



Rescue Radio Station of the Poh Teck Tung Foundation acts as a coordinating center to communicate with rescue units, governmental agencies and media in the collaboration to help and rescue victims of the emergencies, and acts as a 24-hour dispatch center deploying rescue and emergency medical units to the scene. It is the hosting agency of the communication network for public benefits in Bangkok and suburban areas. The station helps support the provision of the emergency medical services of other EMS providers such as the Erawan Center Bangkok EMS, Narenthorn Center and the Provincial Public Health Office; for examples, in recording data relating to the emergency medical operations or ensuring the efficiency of the radio network.
